LAND AT MEY, MEY, THURSO

Offering excellent countryside views stretching across to the Pentland Firth is this land that extends to approximately 3 acres (1.2 hectares). Located within the outskirts of the village, there is direct access from the roadside with electricity, water and telephone point nearby, private drainage would be required. Only a short distance from the Castle of Mey, The Queen Mothers former Highland residence, local schooling is provided at Crossroads Primary School with transport being provided to the high school in the main town of Thurso which is approximately 12 miles away. A comfortable commute from both Wick and Thurso, and approximately 7 miles from the popular tourist village John O'Groats this land would lend itself too many development possibilities subject to suitable planning consent. An ideal setting for a new home or perhaps a holiday cottage given the close proximity to the popular NC500 route, and proximity to Gills Bay, where the mainland terminal for Pentland Ferries offers connections to Orkney. An excellent spot viewing is highly recommended.

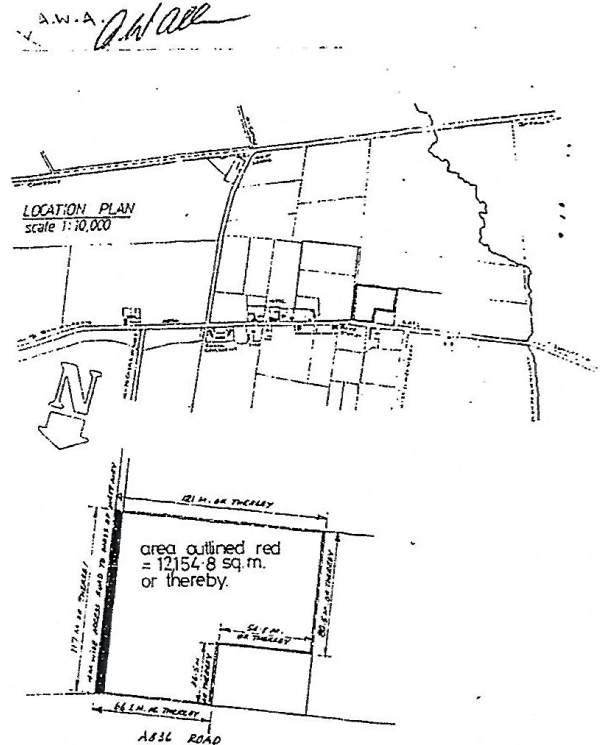
